**WHAT?** We have a fairly full schedule, but there should be lots of time for individual pursuits and visiting with classmates. Here's the itinerary:

- Check-in: Depending on the reservations you have made, you will be checking into the motel on Thursday or Friday. There will be registration packets waiting for you, be sure to ask for them. They will include passes, tickets, name badges, and any necessary maps or other last-minute information. For those of you not staying at the Comfort Inn, the packets will be available at the reception.
- Friday wine-tasting: If there is enough interest shown, we will arrange a 3-hour tour of several prominent local wineries, by motor coach/van/limousine, leaving the motel at about noon on Friday. The Yamhill Valley has been recognized as one of the world's finest appellations. The tour should cost between \$25 and \$30 per person, depending on the number of participants. For all of you who wish to attend, we will confirm by email in advance of your arrival the details and the exact cost, to be paid directly to the tour guide.
- Friday golf: There were not enough people who indicated a preliminary interest to set up an organized tournament. For those of you who would like to arrange to play, we will send you an email in advance with the names and email addresses of your other classmates who have indicated an interest, along with some info about local courses, and you can set up some 3- or 4-somes to play.
- Friday evening reception: There will be a reception at the IMAX theater in the museum complex, from 3:30 PM - to 6:00 PM. There will be a no-host bar for mixed drinks, beer and wine, and some catered hors d'oeuvres. This is the kick-off; be sure to bring your badges!
- Friday dinner: On your own. We will provide info on some good local restaurants in your packet.

- Saturday photo-shoot: We will take group pictures at 10:30 AM in the main aviation museum building, with the "Spruce Goose" in the background.
- Saturday tours: Immediately after the photo-shoot, we will commence the docent-guided tours of the aviation museum. This will last approximately 1-1/4 to 1-1/2 hours. Following that tour, it will be lunch/snack on your own (there is a snack bar in the museum). You may then take the self-guided tour of the space museum (separate building) if you wish, or wait until Sunday. Passes will be in your arrival packet.
- IMAX: This is another possibility for either Saturday afternoon, or on Sunday. Shows are roughly an hour each, and currently include such features as "The Magic of Flight," "Lewis and Clark," and "Space Station 3D." The first showing is at 11:00 AM and the last at 6:30 PM. Information on specific features and show times will be in your packet when you arrive, along with a pass if you requested one.
- Saturday banquet: This begins at 6:30 PM at the Golden Valley Brewery and Pub. Drinks, wine and beer will be available by circulating servers, or at the bar. The banquet will be buffet-style, featuring Angus Springs Ranch Roast Beef and Tuscan Chicken Breast, with salad, side dishes and dessert. I have eaten here many times, and the food is wonderful. We will have some brief remarks from our class president Ray Madonna, and our featured speaker is Jim Willis, the Director of the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs.
